Dear Parent/Caregiver

In early February 2018, letters from both Community Living Dufferin (CLD) and Dufferin Child and Family Services (DCAFS) were sent out to parents/caregivers confirming the transition of the existing Pre-School Resource Program at CLD to the I-CAN (Inclusion for Children with Additional Needs) Program at DCAFS.

Beginning April 1, 2018, the I-CAN Program will be working with licensed Child Care Centres in Dufferin County in supporting children with special and additional needs up to and including the age of 12 years.

Along with the I-CAN Program, DCAFS will now be responsible for the delivery of the Behaviour Support Program and the Summer Inclusion Program.

We are currently in the process of hiring the required staff to ensure that summer inclusion supports are in place for children with special needs. **As in previous years with CLD, parents should register their children in the desired camp(s).** Effective, the week of March 19th, parents and caregivers can go to the DCAFS website to download an application for a Summer Inclusion Worker. Follow the directions below:


